

BASIC OPERATION

TURN ON/OFF THE UNIT

Press O/SRC button to turn on the unit. When the unit is on, press and hold it for 2 seconds to turn off the unit.

SOUND AND SETTING ADJUSTMENT

Shortly press **MENU** button to enter the audio menu as below: BASS -> TRE -> BAL -> FAD -> EQ (CLASS/ROCK/POP/OFF) -> LOUD (ON/OFF) -> AEQ(ON/OFF) -> RESET

After the AEQ is set to ON, Press **MENU** button again, you can boost or cut below frequency: 31Hz / 62Hz / 125Hz / 250Hz / 500Hz / 1KHz / 2KHz / 4KHz / 8KHz / 16KHz

Hold the **MENU** button to enter the system menu as below: SWVOL(20) -> LPF(80) -> AMP(ON/OFF) -> BEEP(ON/OFF) -> P_VOL(19) -> CLOCK(12/24) -> CT(INDEP/SYNC) -> AREA(USA/EUR) -> DX/LOC -> STEREO/MONO

In each item press **VOL+/-** button to set them. **AMP on/off: AMP off:** Muting the speakers output. **AMP on:** Speakers have sound output.

NOTE: every cycle from AMP off to on, the volume value will return to 19.

CLOCK (24/12)

Setting the time to 24 hour or 12 hour format.

P-VOL (Preset VOL)

Setting the power on volume. If the volume on shutdown is lower than the P-VOL value, the volume will be maintained at shutdown volume. If the volume on shutdown is greater than the P-VOL value, the volume will be restored to the P-VOL value.

CT (Clock Time)

CT INDEP: The clock works independently. CT SYNC: The clock will be synchronized to the received RDS station's time.

NOTE: When the time is set manually. The CT will go back to INDEP mode automatically. AREA (USA/EUR): Choose America or Europe region frequency.

BASIC OPERATION (cont.)

INFORMATION PRIORITY OR CLOCK PRIORITY

Shortly press **CLK** button to change the clock priority or information priority.

CLOCK SETTING

Press and hold **CLK** button for 2 seconds. The "**HH**" will flash. Press **VOL+/-** button to change the hour. After that press **MENU/CLK** button the "**MM**" will flash. Press **VOL+/-** button to change the minute. Then press **MENU/CLK** button to confirm.

NOTE: When the time is set, the CT item will go back to INDEP mode automatically.

RESET THE UNIT

In Standby status (B+ on, ACC on, power off.) press and hold ►►I button for 5 seconds to reset the unit to factory settings. (Note: After reset all memory will be lost.)

RADIO OPERATION

Receive a Radio Station

Press **O/SRC** button to select radio source. Then press **BAND** button to select desired band. Shortly press **I**◀◀, ▶▶**I** button to receive the desired radio station.

Press and hold **VOL+/-** button for manual tuning by frequency.

Auto Store

Press and hold **BAND** button for 2 seconds to auto store stations to band 1~3.

Manually Store Station & Recall Preset Station

Receive a desired station. Press and hold the ►II button. It shows "SAVE P1". Press VOL+/- button to select P1~P6 then press MENU button to save.

Listening The Presets Station

Shortly press the Idd, >>I button to select presets and listening

BASIC OPERATION (cont.)

USB OPERATION

When a USB drive is inserted into the MC-110, the unit will play the MP3/WMA file automatically. If a USB drive is already inserted in the MC-110 Keep pressing **O/SRC** button shortly until the USB mode display appears.

Select File

Press Idd, >>I button to skip to next/previous file. Hold Idd, >>I button to fast forward or fast reverse.

Play/Pause

Press ►II button to play or pause the song.

Search Song Operation

Press and hold **BAND** button for 2 seconds to show **NUM** ****, Press **VOL+/-** to enter numbers then press **MENU** button to play.

Repeat/Random Operation

Press and hold ►II button for 2 seconds to select below item: *RPT ALL -> RDM ON -> RPT ONE -> RPT FOLD*

IPHONE Playing

Connect an IPHONE to the USB port of the MC-110 via a USB cable. The operation is same as the USB operation.

AUX IN Operation

Connect the source to the AUX IN connector behind the unit. Then press O/SRC button to switch to AUX IN source.

BLUETOOTH OPERATION

Pairing

On mobile phone, select the Bluetooth item search for the Bluetooth device. "*MC-110*" it should appear in the list, select "*MC-110*" and then input password "0000" if it needs a password. When successfully paired, the BT icon will be displayed on LCD.


Bluetooth Audio

Press ^O/SRC button to switch to *BT MUSIC* mode. Press ►II button to play or pause the song. Press I44, ►►I button to select next/previous song.

Disconnect the Bluetooth

When the mobile phone is paired with the MC-110. In *BT MUSIC* mode, press and hold the **I** button for 2 seconds to disconnect/re-connect the Bluetooth.

INSTALLATION




1. The MC-110 can only be connected to a 12V DC cathode grounding electrical system.

- 2. Do not connect the terminals of the battery until the MC-110 installation is complete.
- 3. Please make sure to connect the yellow wire directly to the positive terminal at the battery(+).
- 4. When changing the fuse, please make sure to disconnect the battery terminals.

MOUNTING

Once a suitable location has been determined, Cut out the mounting hole and secure the MC-100 using the supplied metal mounting bracket. If the bracket needs to be shortened, remove the appropriate number of breakaway segments using a pair of pliers.



- 1. This player should be installed by professional technician.
- 2. Please read the instruction and operation of equipment carefully before installing.
- 3. Make sure to connect other wires before power connection.
- 4. To avoid short circuit. Please make sure all the exposed wire are insulating.
- 5. Please fix all the wires after installation.
- 6. Please make connection to the player accordingly to this instruction manual. Wrong connection may cause damage.
- 7. This player only fit for 12V DC device and please make sure your car belongs to this kind of cathode grounding electrical system.
- 8. Please connect the wires rightly. Wrong connection will cause malfunction or damage the electrical system.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Before going through the checklist, check wiring connection. If any of the problems persist after checklist has been made, consult your nearest service dealer.

Symptom	Cause	Solution
No power	The car ignition switch is not on.	If the power supply is connected to the car accessory circuits, but the engine is not moving, switch the ignition key to "ACC".
	The fuse blown.	Replace the fuse.
No sound	Volume is in minimum	Adjust volume to a desired level.
	Wiring is not properly connected.	Check wiring connection.
The operation keys do not work	The built-in microcomputer is not operating properly due to noise.	Press the reset button.
The radio does not work. The radio station automatic selection does not work	The antenna cable is not connected.	Insert the antenna cable firmly.
	The signals are too weak.	Select a station manually.
